Using Gift Aid means that for every pound you give, we get an extra 28 pence from the Inland Revenue, helping your donation go further. This includes amounts paid in Subs. This means that every £2 of subs can be turned into £2.56 just so long as donations are made through Gift Aid.

Imagine what a difference that could make to the Group, and **it doesn't cost you a thing.**

To qualify for Gift Aid, what you pay in income tax or capital gains tax must at least equal the amount we will claim in the tax year.

Notes

1. You can cancel this declaration at anytime by notifying the Group
2. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the amount of tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the year.
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims you need to cancel you declaration.
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief on your Self Assessment form in relation to Gift Aid donations.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief then ask the Group or contact your local tax office.
